## Dear Shri

The financial year 2018-19 is over now and we have just entered into the new financial year. The telecom industry witnessed entry of all surviving telco's to fixed line fiber business, thus a new era of competition has started. BSNL needs to continue and accelerate with the new initiatives taken in last two quarters.

- a. BharatFibre: Fiber to the home (FTTH) service, branded as BharatFibre, is going to be the Success Mantra in the year 2019-20, for the growth of CFA business in BSNL.
  - 1. Circle wise achievement in physical growth for the year 2018-19 is given in With the introduction of new initiatives like FTTH real-time revenue share and Digital Gram Sewak, there is a substantial improvement in the growth of BharatFiber business in Quarter-4 of 2018-19.
  - 2. The targets for the year 2019-20 for the FTTH business are given in Annexure-B wherein it is required that all the circles must grow minimum at the rate of 10% on month on month basis. Adoption of BharatFibre Mobile App which has been launched recently, for improving the fault maintenance of FTTH service, must be completed in all SSAs by 30th April, 2019 to ensure improvement in quality of service delivery for the BharatFibre service.
- b. Landline & Broad band (ADSL): With an ARPU as high as Rs 650, ADSL broadband is still the bread and butter for CFA segment, the need of the hour is to continue to grow the copper broadband customer base till complete migration to fiber based broadband.
  - The gross and net achievement for the financial year 2018-19 is given in Annexure-C. Though there is a growing trend in the Quarter-4 of 2018-19 and BSNL has provided more than 80 thousand land line, and 90 thousand broad band connection in March and there is a morale boosting milestone of net positive nine thousand connection in Broad band in March, 2019 but the count of disconnections is nullifying the new customer additions.

- ii. The targets for the year 2019-20 is given in Annexure-D wherein it is again expected that there has to be a physical growth of minimum 10% on month on month basis in current financial year.
- c. <u>Disconnections</u>: As it is established now that the efforts made in acquiring a new customer is all most 10 times the efforts made in retaining the customer. So to bring focus on the customers churn in our network, the concept of Churn index (which represents the percentage of customers lost in a period) has been introduced. Keeping an eye on this index, it will alert all stakeholders in the organization put efforts in right direction to retain the existing customer base. The bench mark for Churn Index has been set as 5% (circles must not cross this important mark).
- d. <u>Bill Payments and Expanding Retail-Sales Network</u>: BSNL franchisee/retail network was enabled in December, 2018 for the acceptance of land line/BB bill payment through CBP wallet arrangement. The status of primary sale done by circles for the CBP wallet is given in Annexure-E. Aggressive use of our retail partner network to increase our physical reach to the customers is a vital agenda for this year. Minimum 10% of Billed Amount (ABF) should be collected through retail network every month. This will further help in sale of CFA products through retail network, as customer will be visiting a retailer on regular basis for the bill payment.
- e. <u>Go-Green Initiative</u>: Initiatives have been taken to migrate our land line /Broad band customers to the e-bill format. This will improve the customer experience and importantly reduce the bill printing and delivery cost.

With the implementation of SIP servers in all the four zones, customer consent for e-bill can be taken through the SIP platform. This innovative implementation has been done by CTD recently (as given in Annexure F). All circles must implement the same to ensure migration of 100% customers to the e-bill format, as done by Punjab and Maharashtra Circle.

- f. Wings: In January, 2019 simplified wings customer on-boarding process and mobile-app for the wings service was introduced. Various schemes have been launched to encourage the uptake of this mobile-app base calling service. Circles should pay a special attention to ensure that the customers on-boarded in the free trial period are migrated to regular plans to ensure timely billing for the wings service.
- g. <u>NGN migration</u>: The migration of customers to the NGN platform will help in reducing the operational cost as well as improvement of service quality. The migration targets as given in Annexure-G need to be achieved.

- h. <u>USOF WiFi Project</u>: BSNL has to commission 25,000 Wi fi Hotspots under USOF Wifi Project. Till date, only 19,789 wifi hotspots have been installed and 14,967 no of hotspots have been made live. This project was to be completed by December 2018 and we are already lagging behind the target date given by DOT. The project should be commissioned in all respect by 30th April 2019 putting extra efforts on media provisioning.
- i. Awareness through Whatsapp platform: Corporate Office has been regularly sharing the details of new tariff plans, new initiatives through small creatives on WhatsApp platform. This helps in creating an awareness of what we must convey first to our employees, and then to our customers to sell our products and services in this hyper-competitive market. Similar initiative must be taken by each circle office to see that the information reaches to the lowest level in the organization. Broadcast lists feature of whatsapp in place of groups, shall be made to implement this.

## j. Important Themes/Sales Programs Currently Running:

5 GB broadband trial offer has seen a very good response and this offer has been continued in the month of April, 2019 also. More than 50% land line customer base is a potential customer base for providing home WiFi service. This trial offer should be effectively utilized for migration of land line customers to home WiFi service. Customer communication methods like SMS, email and outgoing calling through media servers installed in Haryana, Gujarat, Kerala and CTD must be done. A growth rate of 10% on month on month base must be ensured.

Bharatfibre demand generation portal was launched in March 2019, and more than 70 thousand leads have been generated through this portal. Circles must ensure (with the help of Call Centre team at **Ajmer and Bangalore**) that these leads are timely converted to Bharatfibre connections (either through BSNL team or the revenue share partner). With this arrangement and ongoing sales efforts, growth rate of 10% on month on month basis is to be achieved.

For enhancing measurability of the Annual Goal setting done above, a **Performance Management Portal (PMP)** has been launched wherein the performance unto JTO/SDO can be measured as per assigned service quality benchmarks and physical growth targets. It should be ensured that all officers upto JTO/SDE are configured in the system along with the targets, and monthly review is done at each SSA level for its effective utilization. Best Officer in the SSA, Best SSA in the Circle, and Best Circle in BSNL shall be declared on quarterly basis.

I am quite sure that with the concerted efforts and galvanization of team support, will be able to achieve the set targets and covert the innovations into a positive trend in the CFA revenues and cash flow.

### Annexure - F

- 1. BSNL Calcutta Telephones IT team, has configured OBD dialing facility through SIP trunk using its own infrastructure and knowledge base.
- 2. SIP trunk from GMSC Chittaranjan to Information Technology Cell has been commissioned and its operational.
- 3. One Telemarketing number obtained from CMTS (+911400221111)
- 4. In-house audio recording facility in windows Desktop with post processing and audio mixing using audacity software.

#### Process: -

- 1. List of active Landline numbers are obtained from CDR team and loaded into mysql database.
- 2. Sound files are added in asterisk media library and necessary dial plan has been created.
- 3. PHP is used to create call files from mysql database and transfer it to asterisk outgoing spool folder. Necessary protection script have been incorporated not to overload outgoing spool folder which may lead to crash the asterisk server.
- 4. Asterisk will auto dial the number using call file + dial plan + media Library.
- 5. System is tested to initiate 200 simultaneous call attempt per min resulting 12000 call attempt per hour. The system was working fine without distortion.
- 6. CDR for successful call are being generated and are regularly analyzed.
- 7. Customer Consent for the go-green initiative is taken using the above stated process.
