Circles were requested to reconciled and submitted certified data, that the claim have been raised uniformly from 01.10.2020. But except three circles (AP, CG, Tel & AP) none of the circles have submitted their compliance to this office. BSNL management has sought clarifications/information on the under mentioned points, as DoT claim detail submitted by circles very less as circles have not accounted uniformly from 01.10.2000 . Detail to be supplied is as give below:-


1. Kindly ascertain that claim raised from 01.10.2000 are uniformly accounted including Service Tax rate /GST prevailing during the period.

2. Year wise information in the table given to assess that claimed amount is consistent

3. Circle IFA should certify that all the billable connections have been taken into consideration from 01.10.2000 onwards as information submitted by circle is very low.

So, it is requested look into the above points on priority and compliance the same by **15.12.2020**, so that final amount may be submitted to BSNL Management for approval and further submission of BSNL's claim to DoT.
