Sub: Review of policy on pay-by-date, dunning schedule and dunning threshold for Landline, Broadband and FTTH.

Review of existing policy on pay-by-date, dunning schedule and dunning threshold was under consideration of BSNL Management to maximize cash flow and collection efficiency as well as to minimize volume of unpaid bills.

2. It has been decided that in supersession of letters under reference, the revised pay-by-date, schedule of DNP (disconnection for non-payment) and amount of dunning threshold of Landline, Broadband and FTTH will be as below:

a) Pay-by-date and dunning:

Note: In South Zone, existing schedule of pay-by-date (15th day from bill issue date) and OGB (22nd day of bill issue date) will continue up to bill issue month Oct., 2020 in accordance with CO, BSNL letter No. 2-2/2011-BSNL/TR(Pt.) dated 26.06.2018 (under reference at Srl. No. 6 above).

b) Dunning threshold:
